Training Level 1: **Introduction to Chief Architect Version 9.5**

This course is an introduction to Chief Architect software consisting of 4 sessions of 3 hours, over two days. It provides participants with the basic knowledge required to produce a set of printed plans from a 3D Model.

Chief Architect is an object based modelling and draughting programme. Instead of drawing lines, Chief Architect places objects which are used to create the 3D model.

As you create your design in plan view, a 3D model is being created from which elevations, cross sections and perspective views can be derived. Automatic roof generation and automatic dimensions save time and 2D detail drawings produced using the CAD tools can be used over again in subsequent drawings where relevant.
